Course Description:

The Less-Lethal Shotgun Specialist Instructor Course provides an instructor-level certification on the use and application of any manufacturer's 12-gauge less-lethal munitions, non-flexible and 12-gauge diversionary devices in close, medium, and long-range applications. This course will also include the Royal Arms FBG-MK3 12-gauge Impact initiated Flash-Bang. The course is one day in length and provides a 3-year agency instructor certification upon the participant's successful completion of all course requirements.

- Use of Force Training Model & documentation best practices
- Principles of Specialized Shotgun Munitions
- Tactical, environmental and safety considerations for employment of less-lethal munitions

- Sample Policy and guidelines for department implementation
- Less-Lethal, live practical application
